DAY 1 CASABLANCA - RABAT

Fri, May 13th

Arrive in Casablanca and transfer to the Moorish city of Rabat, capital of Morocco. Check-in at your luxurious accommodations and enjoy a leisurely afternoon in this beautiful setting. Join us in the evening for a Welcome Dinner at the hotel restaurant.

DAY 2 RABAT - FEZ

Sat, May 14th

Begin your day this morning in the seaside capital city of Rabat, a beautiful blend of Arabic and European influences. Wide boulevards, elegant French colonial buildings, Moorish palaces...take it all in. Our tour will take us to the **Mohammed V Mausoleum**, dedicated to the founder of modern Morocco, grandfather of the current king, **the Mauresque-style Hassan Tower** and **Oudaya Kasbah** with its palm-dotted Andalusian garden.

We will then journey overland to a winery outside **Meknes** for wine tasting followed by lunch. Take in the flavours and aromas of Moroccan wines and its traditional cuisine.

After, we will leave for Fez, stopping to explore **Volubilis**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that houses some of the best - preserved Roman ruins in North Africa. We will arrive in Fez in the early evening and after hotel check-in, we will rejoin the group for dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3 FEZ Sun, May 15th

Explore **Fez el-Bali (Old Fez)**, the cultural heart of Morocco. Founded in the eighth century by **Moulay Idriss I**, this imperial capital was a renowned center of medieval learning. Stroll the labyrinthine old quarter, with its 9,000 narrow lanes, alleys and **souks**, on a market visit of exceeding authenticity. Watching local craftsmen in action — working with bronze and pottery — makes for an engaging artisan visit as well. Proceed to the intricately detailed **Karaouine**. Built in 859 AD, it is one of the oldest still-functioning universities in the world. Our tour will be followed by a free afternoon and we will join the group again for dinner at the hotel restaurant, accompanied by a local academic who will talk to us about the role of women in today's Morocco.

DAY 4 FEZ – ERFOUD – MERZOUGA

Mon, May 16th

Today we will leave the bustle of the city behind and head for the spectacular snow-capped **High Atlas Mountains**. Pass through **Ifrane** before reaching the great cedar forests of **Azrou**. After stopping for lunch at **Midelt**, continue through the magnificent **Ziz Gorges**...Our destination is **Erfoud**, where the red sand buildings contrast against the patches of greenery and surrounding desert. After the day's scenic drive, settle into your luxurious tent in the village of **Merzoug**a in the **Sahara Desert** before gathering for dinner at the desert camp. Tonight's dinner will be accompanied by live folkloric **Gnaoua** music troupe. **Accommodations**: Merzouga Luxury Desert Camp

DAY 5 MERZOUGA – OUARZAZATE

Tue, May 17th

Rise early this morning to witness the magnificent **Merzouga** sunrise, and after breakfast transfer back on 4x4 WD to meet the bus and depart to **Erfoud**. Journey overland to **Ouarzazate**, nicknamed "the door of the desert" and once a stopping point for African traders travelling to the cities of Morocco and on to Europe. Drive along the scenic route of a **Thousand Kasbahs** and the **Dades River Valley** before entering **Ouarzazate**, where everything is calm, beautiful and fresh-the image of the authentic south of Morocco where time has stood still for centuries. Arrive at your delightful oasis of a hotel and after checkin, join the group for dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Accommodations: Hotel Le Berbere Palace, or similar (2 nights)

DAY 6 OUARZAZATE

Wed, May 18th

Today we will meet the locals and enjoy a feast of an authentic **Berber Lunch** with a Berber family in traditional houses. We return to our hotel later and rejoin the group for dinner at the hotel restaurant. **Meals:** B, D

DAY 7 OUARZAZATE/AIT BENHADDOU – MARRAKECH

Thur, May 19th

We will journey over **the High Atlas Mountains** again this morning, but first we will stop at **Kasbah of Ait Ben Haddou**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site where many famous movies have been filmed. After, continue your journey towards the fascinating "**Red City**" **of Marrakech**. After hotel check-in and some free time, join us again in the evening for a dinner and show event.

DAY 8 MARRAKECH

Fri, May 20th

Today, begin to unearth the secrets of Marrakech, starting with the 16th century **Saadian Tombs** and the fragrant **Menara Gardens**...marvel at its architectural jewels, including the soaring **Koutoubia Minaret**, and then visit **Bahia Palace** with its extraordinary tiles and opulent courtyards.

We will continue with a visit to the botanical treasures of Marrakech, including the famous **Majorelle Gardens**, designed by the French artist **Jacques Majorelle** in 1924 and then purchased by **Ives St Laurent in 1980**.

Afterward, visit **Djemaa el-Fna**, Marrakech's main square, which is filled with orange juice stalls and vendors, along with fire-eaters, acrobats, dancers and street musicians performing at every turn. Our tour will be followed by free time to stroll the city's fabled, labyrinthine *souks*.

We will join the group again this evening for dinner at a famous local restaurant.

DAY 9 MARRAKECH

Sat, May 21st

Today we will learn to cook with Moroccan spices. We will participate at a hands-on cooking class where we will prepare and enjoy a typical 3-course Moroccan meal.

DAY 10 MARRAKECH – CASABLANCA

Sun, May 22nd

This morning we depart Marrakech for the "White City" of Casablanca. As we enter this cosmopolitan city, we will take in a panoramic tour of its sights to view the Royal Palace, the architecture of Place Mohamed V, Anfa, the residential area and the romantic beachfront with its world-famous shops, restaurants and nightclubs. We will visit the famous Hassan II Mosque, the largest in the world outside of Mecca. We will end our sightseeing with a lunch at a local restaurant, accompanied by an academic who will share his thoughts and views on Morocco's current life affairs. We will check-in at our hotel after and the rest of the day is at our leisure.

Mon, May 23rd


